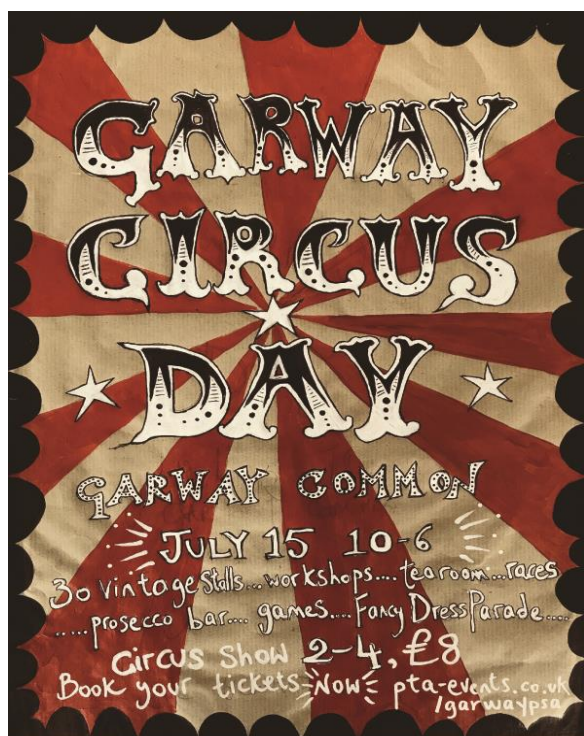
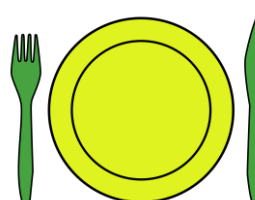
SCHOOL LUNCHES

You will have received a letter home last week in relation to our new catering provider AiP. At the beginning of this week also sent home the new menus for the Autumn Term.

As this is the start of a new academic year you will be required to make all bookings for the first week we return in September before we finish for the summer holidays.

The last day for ordering on Parent Pay will be Tuesday 17th July at midnight. This date is also a taster event for AiP and you are all invited to sample their food.

If your child has any food allergies then you will be required to book a separate meal which is detailed on the menu each day. This meal will be specifically for your child and will need to be pre-ordered from the caterer. We have an Allergen Menu Request available from the School Office which you will need to complete in order to receive this tailor made meal option.
